



## MarketAxess Announces Monthly Volume Statistics for May 2021

NEW YORK, June 02, 2021 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- MarketAxess Holdings Inc. (Nasdaq: MKTX), the operator of a leading electronic trading platform for fixed-income securities, and the provider of market data and post-trade services for the global fixed-income markets, today announced monthly trading volume for May 2021 of \$478.7 billion consisting of \$204.4 billion in credit volume and \$274.3 billion in rates volume.

Reported MarketAxess volume in all product categories includes only fully electronic trading volume.
